

Serged Pocket Pillow w/ Zipper

Supply List and Class Prep Instructions:

NOTE: It is **VERY** important that you pre-cut all fabrics **BEFORE** this class.

Supplies You Bring:

- Your serger with it's power cord, and all of it's basic accessories including threading card and the screw driver for changing needles.
- Cording / Piping Foot (You'll need this foot to make the custom piping and to insert the zipper)
- 20" zipper
- Wonder Tape (double sided adhesive wash-away tape)
- Pins or Wonder Clips
- Fabric Marking Pen or Pencil
- 3/8" cording – 100" long
- Fabric A: For making the custom piping: pre-cut fabric strips from selvage to selvage 1 3/4" wide (cut 4 strips)
- Fabric B: Pillow Front: Cut a 16" x 16" square of cotton fabric
- Fabric B Same as Pillow Front for Pillow Back: Cut two 8 1/2" x 16" rectangles of cotton fabric
- Fabric C & D: Pocket Front: Cut two 16" wide x 4 1/2" tall rectangles of contrasting cotton fabric
- Fabric A: Pocket Lining: 16" x 8 1/2" cotton fabric
- One sided Fusible Fleece or Fusible Batting: Cut one 16" x 16" square, Cut two 8 1/2" x 16" rectangles (If you can't find fusible fleece or batting, just get regular low loft batting and a roll of **OESD Soft Web** or a can of **Sulky KK 2000 Temporary Spray Adhesive** - available at Humble Sewing Center - so you'll be able to get the desired results.)
- THREAD: Bring 1 spool of poly yarn serger thread (the same color as your piping fabric), and 4 spools of regular serger thread (the same color as your piping fabric)
- Bring extra fabric and batting scraps to test stitches
- Bring extra needles (just in case)
