

Supply List & Cutting Instructions

Heirloom Serger Purse

Supplies:

You Bring – serger, cording/piping foot, standard foot, optional clear foot, optional open toe foot, optional blind hem foot, power cord, pedal, threading card and/or instruction book, screwdriver for changing needles, extra serger needles

Optional – you may also wish to bring a simple sewing machine (we will have a few to lend during class as well)

Thread- 3 cones serger thread to match fabric, 2 spools sewing thread to match fabric, 2 spools 12 wt Sulky or Poly Yarn to match fabric (for wave stitch)

Notions Needed- wonder tape, glue stick or kk2000 temporary spray adhesive or 505 temporary spray adhesive, bodkin or large safety pin, fast turns or tube turners

<p>½ yard black linen blend (45" wide) ½ yard black and white print (45" wide) ¼ yard print – inner pocket option ¼ yard Victorian Eyelet (2" - 2 ½" wide) ½ yard Victorian Bridging 5/8 yard Black Ribbon (1/4" wide) ¼ yard White Classic Cotton (45"/60" wide) 1 yard Pellon Flex Foam Interfacing Stabilizer ¼ yard Fusible Batting One magnetic purse snap Pocket zipper – 14" or larger Adjustable Strap - Two rectangular or D-rings One Double rectangular ring</p>	<p>PLEASE pre-cut ALL pieces BEFORE class</p> <p>Black Linen Blend – 3/8 yard Strap – 2 ¾" x 60" Purse Body – 2 pieces, 9 ½" x 12" Flap – 2 pieces, 9" x 6"</p> <p>Black and White Print – ½ yard Straps 1 ¼" x 60" Purse lining – 2 pieces, 12" square Flap lining – 10 ½" square</p> <p>White Classic Cotton – ¼ yard Flap Inner lining – 7 ½" x 10 ½"</p> <p>Pellon Flex Foam Interfacing Stabilizer 20" wide - 1 yard Base – 2 pieces, 9"x12" Strap – 1 ¼" x 30" (cut 2 pieces)</p> <p>Fusible Batting 7 ½" x 10 ½"</p> <p>Pockets Zippered 8"x20" Folded 8"x16"</p>
