

Learn to Quilt: Placemat



In this class you will be making a quilted placemat using a pattern by Anorina Morris. This class will give you the basic knowledge of quilting while working on a project from start to finish. This will include cutting fabric, piecing, basting, quilting and binding.

The supply list is for 1 placemat. If you are purchasing fabric for this class adjust the fabric requirements to be able to make additional placemats on your own at home.

Supply List:

All fabric should be 100% cotton

Ten to Fifteen: $\frac{3}{4}$ " to 2" strips that are 4" long (Your strips can be wider and can be cut down in class)

Two - solid fabric pieces for the borders - approximately 10" x 20". The size of these will be dependent upon the width of the strips and size of the placemat that you want.

One - 13" x 16" piece of batting (this is an approximate size and can be made to suit your personal preferences)

One - 13" x 16" backing fabric (I used a flannel print which I think works best)

Two - 3 1/2" x Width Of Fabric for binding

Sewing Machine in good working condition

Sewing Machine Needles

Sewing Machine feet to include – Standard Foot, Quarter Inch Guide Foot & a Walking Foot (or equivalent for your machine)

Rotary cutter, ruler and mat to use by your sewing machine

Basting spray or basting pins

Thread to match your fabric choices

Snacks and/or lunch for yourself as there will be a short break in the middle of the class.

****All machines brought to class should be in good working condition. We cannot service your machine during a class. If your machine breaks during class, we can check it in for service. No same day service is available. There are no refunds on classes. You must know basic operation of your machine to attend any hands-on class at HSC.
