Sewing Tools You Need

- Sewing Machine and standard presser foot; we used the Skyline S7
- Open Toe Satin Stitch foot
- Zipper foot
- AcuFeed™ Flex Standard foot

Fabric and Other Supplies

NOTE: Our fabric selections are from the Ventana Twill collection from Robert Kaufman Fabrics along with a standard rip stop nylon for the lining. We do recommend a heavier weight fabric like a twill or light canvas for this bag; a quilting cotton would not hold up as well.

- 1 yard of 44"+ wide twill weight fabric for the main exterior panels; we used [Ventana Twill in Jasmine](#) from Robert Kaufman Fabrics
- ½ yard of 44"+ wide twill weight fabric for the accent exterior panels and handles; we used [Ventana Twill in Charcoal](#) from Robert Kaufman Fabrics
- 1 yard of 54"+ wide [ripstop nylon](#); we used light gray (we recommend a light color for the lining)
NOTE: You will use the full yard; if you are worried about cutting accuracy, get 1½ yards.
- 1½ yards of 20"+ one-sided fusible foam; such as [Pellon Flex Foam](#)
- 2½ yards of 20"+ lightweight fusible interfacing, such as [Pellon Shape Flex](#)
- ¼ yard of 45"+ mid-weight, super-crisp fusible interfacing, such as [Pellon Déco Fuse](#)
- 2½ yards of 1" cotton webbing for the adjustable straps and D-ring tab
- 1 yard of ¼" no-roll elastic; such as [Dritz Soft Stretch Elastic](#)
- ½ yard of ½" ribbon, webbing or similar for the interior leash; we used black grosgrain ribbon

- 1 yard of 1½" piping cord (also called welt); we used Conso cotton piping in a size #8. At these larger sizes, there are two distinctly different sizing methods. Some companies use the diameter of the cut end, which in this case is ½". Others used the circumference, which for our sample is 1½".
- All purpose thread to match fabric
- Matching all purpose thread or 30wt thread in a color to match the darker of the two twill fabrics; we used Sulky Cotton 30wt in Almost Black
- Hardware:
 - FOUR 1" Swivel Hooks; such as [Dritz Fashion Swivel Hooks](#) - we used an antique brass finish
 - ONE 1" D-Ring; such as [Dritz Fashion D-Rings](#) - we used an antique brass finish
 - TWO 1" Slide Buckles; such as [Dritz Fashion Slide Adjusters](#) - we used an antique brass finish
 - TWO ⅜" Metal Grommets; such as [Dritz Large Grommets](#) - we used an antique brass finish
 - ONE ½" Swivel Hook; such as the [Dritz Small Swivel Hook and Ring Set](#) - we used a brushed brass finish
 - ONE ¾" Magnetic Snap; such as [Dritz ¾" Magnetic Snaps](#) - we used a gold finish
 - ONE 12" Metal Zipper - such as the [YKK 12" Brass and Black Zipper with Decorative Fob](#)
- See-through ruler
- Fabric pen or pencil
- Iron and ironing board
- Scissors and/or rotary cutter and mat
- Small, sharp scissors to cut grommet holes
- Seam gauge
- Seam ripper
- Straight pins
- Hand sewing needle
- Large safety pin
