Birds on a Wire Appliqué Pillow

Sewing Tools You Need

- Sewing Machine and standard presser foot; we used the *Memory Craft 9400*
- Open Toe Satin Stitch foot
- Zipper foot
- Automatic Buttonhole foot
- Button sewing foot
- Edge Guide foot

Fabric and Other Supplies

NOTE: Our fabric selections are from within a variety of collections from Riley Blake Fabrics. Yardage is required for base panels and the piping, but the birds themselves measure from *apx. 8" - 9½" in height x 3" - 6½" in width* and so can be cut from yardage or layer cakes or other large pre-cuts or scraps.

- 1½ yards of 44"+ wide quilting weight fabric for the front and back base panels (Star in Teal in our sample from the Riley Blake Just Sayin' collection by My Mind's Eye)
- 1 yard of 44"+ wide quilting weight fabric for the piping and back button placket (Gold Sparkle Kisses in our sample from the Riley Blake Doodlebug Designs collection)
- ¼ yard, pre-cut or scrap in SIX DIFFERENT coordinating quilting weight fabrics for the six bird appliqués – we used the following:
 - Bird #1: Main in Pink from the Bloom Where You're Planted collection by Lori Whitlock for Riley Blake
 - Bird #2: Main in Yellow from the Monday, Monday collection by Jill Finley for Riley Blake
 - Bird #3: Main in Mint from the Just Sayin' collection by My Mind's Eye for Riley Blake
 - Bird #4: Floral in Mint from the Butterflies & Berries collection by Riley Blake

- Bird #5: Birds in Red from the Monday, Monday collection by Jill Finley for Riley Blake
- Bird #6: Christie in Blue from the Hotel Frederiksted collection by Jennifer Paganelli for Free Spirit
- ¾ yard of 45"+ fusible fleece; such as Pellon Thermolam Plus
- 2½ yards of 20"+ lightweight fusible interfacing, such as Pellon Shape Flex
- ¼ yard of 45"+ mid-weight fusible interfacing, such as Pellon Décor Bond
- 3 yards of ¼" piping cord
- Roll of paper-backed fusible web for appliqué, such as Pellon Wonder Under
- THREE 7/8" - 1" buttons
- All purpose thread to match fabric
- Matching all purpose thread or 30wt thread in **a**) a color slightly darker than the base fabric for the bird bodies appliqué (we used a dark teal), **b**) a bright orange/yellow for the bird beaks, and **c**) a slightly off-white for the wires. We used cotton thread in a matte finish, but that is optional; rayon would also be an option.
- See-through ruler
- Fabric pen or pencil
- Iron and ironing board
- Scissors and/or rotary cutter and mat
- Seam gauge
- Seam ripper
- Straight pins
