

Serger Class: Apron Created by: Jennifer Sosa / Educator & Sales Rep. Humble Sewing Center

Supply List:

Must bring your own serger, it's accessories, power cord, instruction manual to this class.

Must be able to thread your serger to attend this class.

Fray Check, 1 large safety pin, Straight pins, Scissors, Rotary Cutter & Ruler, Frixion Pen or Fabric Chalk,

1 jumbo ric rac pkg (for apron pocket), 4 cones Maxi-Lock thread,

2 spools Poly-Yarn thread for wave stitch (coordinating colors),

1 roll of 3/8 inch wide grosgrain ribbon (to accent apron ruffle),

1 pkg Floriani stitch perfection tape ¼" wide (needle friendly, double sided, wash-away, sticky tape),

1 yard main fabric for Apron

1 yard coordinating fabric for ruffle, pocket, contrast upper band, and practice stitches

1/3 yard coordinating fabric for apron ties, pocket binding, contrast strip for upper band

Note: If you are having trouble deciding on colors of fabric and threads, please see included Apron photos.

To allow you more time for learning and practicing techniques, please pre-cut all you're your fabric BEFORE class.

See Cutting instructions below:

From 1 yard main fabric, CUT one rectangular section that measures 24"x29" for the apron, CUT one 5"x width of fabric for technique practice during class

From 1 yard coordinating fabric: CUT one 2 ½"x24" section for contrast upper band, CUT one 10"x11 ½" section for pocket, CUT three 5" wide strips across the width of the fabric (selvage to selvage) for ruffles

From 1/3 yard coordinating fabric: CUT from selvage to selvage – CUT three 1 3/8" strips for pocket binding and contrast upper band, CUT four 1 ¾" strips for apron straps
