I require **two hours payment** at the time we book your lesson.

Sewing Machine, Tools and Supplies:

*** Your sewing machine should be clean and in good working condition. Be familiar with the machine (unless your lesson is to learn to use a machine you already have) and bring all presser feet, foot pedal, and anything you think you may need along with your sewing machine instruction manual.

You will need to bring all necessary items for your project or lesson. This includes, fabric, thread, all tools included with your machine, etc. Check the supply list below.

PRIVATE LESSON POLICY: All private lessons require prepayment at the time of scheduling. Private lessons are non-refundable and held to a strict cancellation policy; please be sure of your schedule prior to scheduling a private lesson. Cancellations received 48 hours before the day of the private lesson, will be offered a 1 time reschedule. Cancellations received less than 48 hours before the day of the private lesson or no-shows will forfeit their lesson fees. Arriving more than 15 minutes late for your lesson may be a forfeit of fees and your appointment will end at the scheduled end time.

Class Policies:



1. You must be pre-registered to attend a class at Sew Vac Outlet (Humble Sewing Center).
2. Classes are reserved on a first-come basis. Only full payment of the class fee will reserve a spot in the class for you. Payments will be processed at the time of registration. It helps us, and helps the classes to make if you sign up as early as possible.
3. Please mark class dates and times on your calendar. If you cannot attend your class and you would like a refund, you must cancel within 48 hours prior to the class. Otherwise, class fees are not refundable unless we cancel because minimum enrollment is not met.
4. Many classes have waiting lists, so if you cannot attend, please let us know so your space can be filled.
5. Supply lists are listed on our website with the class description. The class schedule is offered as a courtesy and a service to our customers. We appreciate your support by purchasing thread, needles, stabilizers, etc. at Humble Sewing Center. We do not carry all of the supplies that you will need for your class in the store, so please contact your instructor if you need help locating any of the other supplies.
6. Classes will start promptly—please arrive 10-15 minutes early so that you are set up and ready to go when class starts. Late arrivals disrupt the class and inconvenience the educator and other attendees. We understand that sometimes unavoidable situations arise, but we do ask you to help us in this matter.
7. Most of our classes require a sewing machine or serger in class. When you bring your machine, be sure to remember the electrical cord, the foot control, all accessories and the owner's manual. We cannot lend power cords, hoops, foot pedals, accessory feet or other supplies for use during classes.
8. You must know how to operate your sewing machine to attend any Hands-On classes at HSC. If you have not sewn for a while or are borrowing a friend's machine, please familiarize yourself with the machine before coming to class. Unless otherwise noted, these are not intended to be machine operation guide classes.
9. Cellular phones should be set to vibrate during class as a courtesy to other students and the instructor.
10. Software Classes: Please come with the latest software updates already downloaded and installed on your laptop before class begins. If the software requires a dongle (security device), bring it with you.
